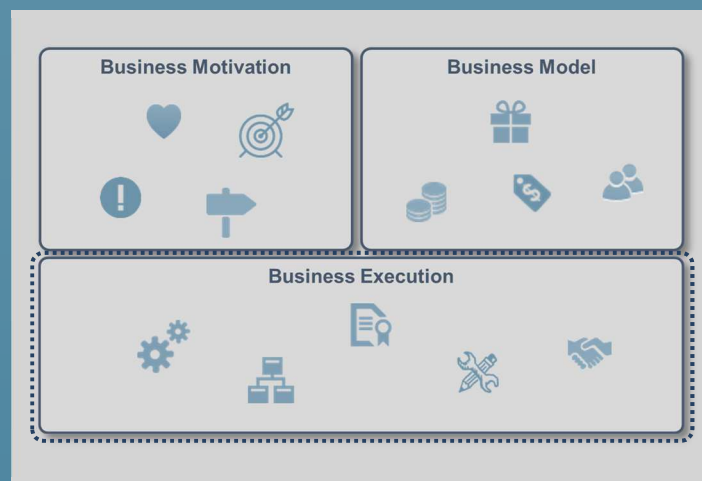


Advanced Course on Bus. Arch. Mgmt.

Course Content



Our business architecture management (BAM) advanced course “Business Operations”, which is accredited by the Business Architecture Guild (and can be used as part of the preparation for the exam to become a Certified Business Architect®), offers specifics about elements and corresponding methods / techniques of architectural management at the level of business execution (e.g., processes, functions, objects), illustrated based on examples from practice. In particular, the course deals with the following topics:

- Overview of business operations / execution elements as part of the business architecture
- Capturing and modeling of current business operations / execution (capabilities, processes / functions, objects, organization, culture, etc.)
- Integration of the different business operations / execution perspectives
- Business operations / execution patterns
- Target business operations / execution design

Course Organization

The course is organized as a 2-day on-site class. It is comprised of presentations, moderated discussions, and practical exercises / assignments. The course is based primarily on the BIZBOK Guide® (A Guide to the Business Architecture Body of Knowledge®) and our book “Business Architecture Management – Architecting the Business for Consistency and Alignment”, of which every attendee receives a printed copy.

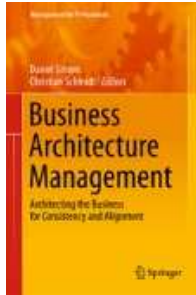
Target Audience
